

What is the problem we are trying to fix?



There are about 4.4 million Australians with disability.



Compared to people without disability, people with disability have lower opportunities in education, less money and poorer health.

According to the Australian Institute of Health and Welfare:



 People with disability find it harder to get a job and more difficult to keep it



People with disability have lower access to healthcare



 People with disability experience high or very high mental stress



 People with disability experience more violence than people without disability

The need for a new way.



People with disability experience discrimination in Australia.

Discrimination means being left out or treated unfairly because of your disability.

Being left out can happen because of:



Inaccessible spaces



Poor attitudes about people with a disability

It is not because of the disability itself.


